Context

This event will officially open this year's World Teachers' Day (WTD) celebrations. UNESCO's Assistant Director-General for Education will be joined by the Heads of co-convening partners UNICEF, ILO and Education International to recognize the work of teachers worldwide, to take stock of achievements, and

to raise awareness of the challenges faced in the profession as education systems adapt to the ‘new normal’ post-COVID-19, while seeking to ‘build back better.’

After WTD is formally inaugurated, the three winners of the 6th UNESCO-Hamdan bin Rashid Al-Maktoum Prize for Outstanding Practice and Performance in Enhancing the Effectiveness of Teachers will be announced by UNESCO Director-General Ms Audrey Azoulay and His Highness Sheikh Hamdan Bin Rashid Al-Maktoum, of the United Arab Emirates. The occasion will also serve to launch the “Knowledge Platform” of the International Task Force on Teachers for Education 2030.

Following the Award Ceremony, the projects of the three laureates will be discussed in greater detail by the winners during a panel discussion on connectivity and learning. The session will be moderated by the president of the Prize’s Selection Committee. The event will then build on this discussion with a session featuring the top ten short-listed projects of this year’s UNESCO-Hamdan Prize for the Effectiveness of Teachers.
